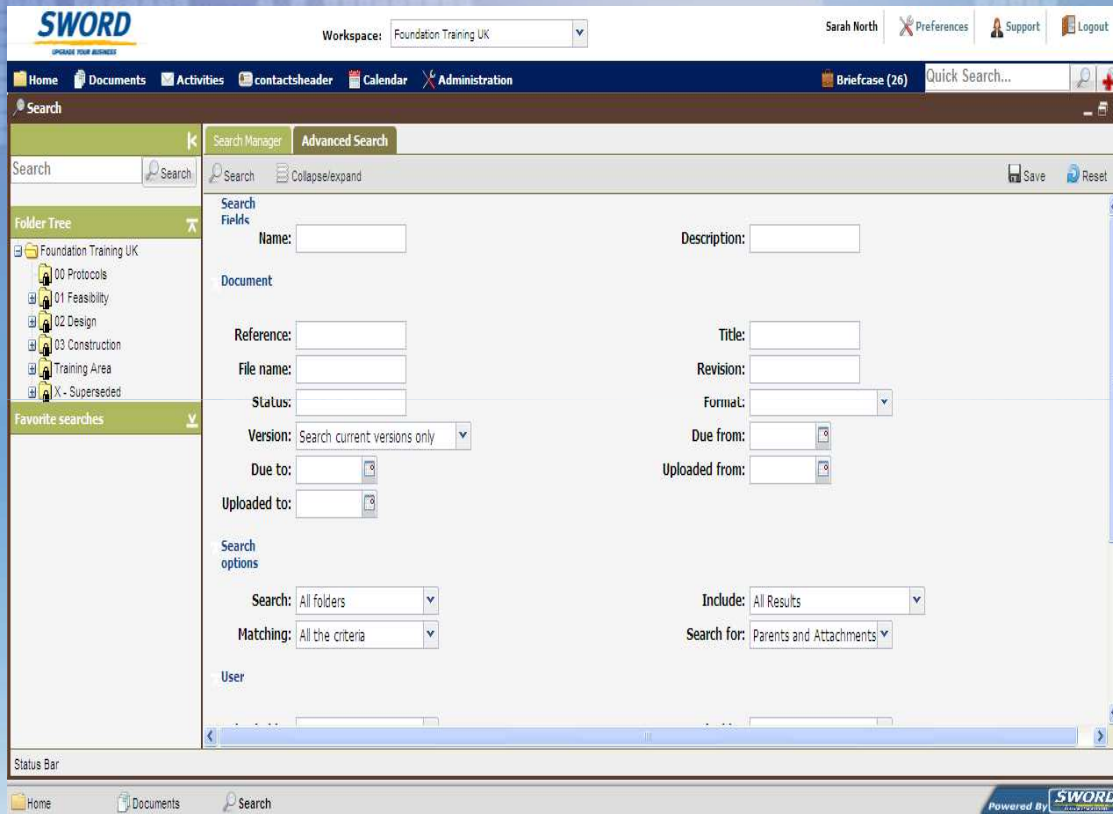

The search can now be opened from any window, you no longer have to be in a folder.

By opening the search in a new window you can return to another area without losing any information.

The document quick search remains in the same place as before

The advanced search can be accessed here

The search opens in a separate window so you can return to a folder or activity without losing your results

You can save your searches directly from the search screen by giving it a name & description & clicking save

The search results open in a new tab so you can easily return to your search page

The export to excel is still available

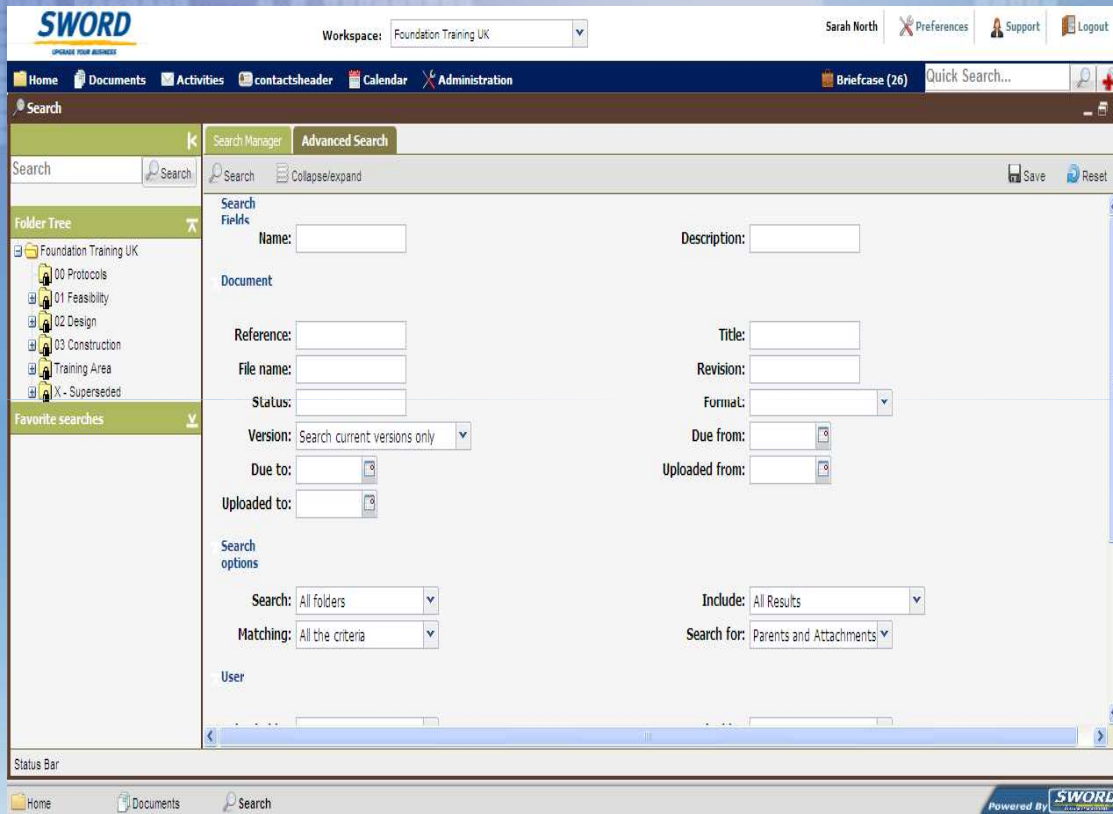
